10 Apr 11 ARRIVAL – SIEM REAP [-/L/D]
Arrive in Siem Reap International airport by **SQ 5026 at 11.50am** and transfer to hotel for check in.
Lunch at hotel.
Visit Angkor Wat Temple until sunset.
Dinner at local restaurant
Accommodation at Angkor holiday hotel , first class double room

- 11 Apr 11 SIEM REAP [B/L/D]
 Breakfast at hotel.
 Morning visit to South Gate of Angkor Thom, Bayon, Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, Elephants Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King.
 Lunch at local restaurant
 Afternoon visit Ta Prohm, Preah Khan and Neak Pean temple.
 Dinner at local restaurant with Apsara dance performance.
 Accommodation at Angkor holiday hotel , first class double room
- 12 Apr 11 SIEM REAP - HANOI [B/L/-]
 Breakfast at hotel.
 In the morning visit Floating village and take a boat trip on Tonle Spa.
 Lunch at local restaurant
 Afternoon visit Artisans D'Angkor and local market.
 Transfer to Siem Reap airport for departure flight **VN 842 at 18.05pm** to Hanoi. Meet on arrival at **19.45pm** in Hanoi / Noi Bai International Airport and transfer to the hotel for check in.
 Accommodation at InterContinental Hotel Hanoi – *own arrangement*
- 13 Apr 11 HANOI –CITY TOUR [-/L/-]
 Breakfast at the hotel.
 Full-day city tour including visits of the most remarkable sites as Ho Chi Minh's former Residence, the One Pillar Pagoda and Army Museum
 Lunch at local restaurant
 Continue by the visit of the Temple of Literature, built in the 11th century as Vietnam's first university, the Fine Arts Museum and Quan Thanh Temple.
 Panoramic cyclo tour followed by a visit of Ngoc Son Temple and Hoan Kiem Lake.
 Water Puppet Show, the unique Vietnamese traditional art.
 Dinner on own arrangement
 Accommodation at InterContinental Hotel Hanoi – *own arrangement*
- 14 Apr 11 HANOI – HA LONG [-/L/D]
 Breakfast at the hotel.
 Depart Hanoi to Ha Long Bay by road through the rich farmlands of the Red River Delta and the scenery of rice fields (harvest time: 5th month and 10th month of Lunar New Year), water buffalos and everyday Vietnamese village life on both side of the highway No.18.
12.00 Check-in at Bhaya Café, Halong City. Embark on Bhaya Classic for a Welcome Cocktail followed by a cruise briefing.
13.00 Savor a delicious Vietnamese buffet lunch as Bhaya Classic heads to Bai Tu Long Bay passing the towns of Hon Gai and Cam Pha, Oan Lagoon, Mat Quy (Monster Head) and Am Tich (Teapot) Islets and Vung Vieng fishing village.
15.30 Visit the fishing village by local rowing boat (01 hour) then return to the vessel for free time at your leisure or join one of the following optional activities:
 Kayak into the village or swim near the boat (**guest `s account**)
 Optional onboard activities: Sunbathing, traditional massage, etc.;
 Trip by tender to an isolated pristine beach for swimming, etc.
17.00 Bhaya Classic cruises through the Bay to its overnight anchorage near Ho Dong Tien.
 Happy Hour & Vietnamese cooking demonstration on the Sundeck.
19.30 Sumptuous Seafood Set-dinner onboard.
21.00 Retire to your cabin or join the fishing program. Overnight aboard Bhaya Classic (deluxe cabin)

- 15 Apr 11 HA LONG – HANOI -HUE [B/L/D]
06.15 Start your day with Tai Chi on the Sundeck while complimentary tea & coffee are served.
07.00 Bhaya Classic weighs anchor to cruise through the Bay passing beautiful spots like Trong (Drum), Trinh Nu (Virgin) and Me Cung Caves, Coc Ngoi (Toad) Islet, etc.
08.30 Explore the Surprise Cave (Sung Sot).
09.30 Return to Bhaya Classic. Buffet brunch (early lunch) is served onboard. The vessel cruises leisurely back to harbor.
11.00 Disembark at Bhaya Café.
 Pick up and transfer back to Hanoi airport for the late evening flight by **VN1545 at 20.10pm**, en route visit Phu Lang pottery village.
 Arrival in Hue at **21.20pm** and transfer to hotel.
 Dinner and accommodation at Saigon – Morin Hotel, Superior double room
- 16 Apr 11 HUE – DA NANG – HOI AN [B/L/D]
 Breakfast at the hotel.
 Starting half day tour visit Hue, the royal city of Vietnam’s last ruling dynasty. Take a boat trip on Perfume River to visit Thien Mu Pagoda and continue to visit the Imperial Citadel and Dong Ba Market.
 Lunch at local restaurant
 Depart to Danang across the Hai Van Pass (Pass of the Ocean Clouds), passing through many pretty red-tiled villages with fruit orchards, enjoying spectacular views of sky and sea, en route stop to visit Cham Museum (if time permit) before proceed to check in hotel in Hoi An.
 Dinner at local restaurant
 Accommodation at Hoi An Ancient House River resort, Superior double room
- 17 Apr 11 HOI AN [B/L/-]
 Breakfast at the hotel.
 Take a city tour to discover this historic town which used to be a prosperous seaport city during the 16th to 18th centuries. Visit Hoi An colourful local market, Tan Ky old house, Fukien Assembly Hall, and the 400-year-old Japanese covered bridge. Travelers can also see local residents raise silkworms and produce silk for Hoi An's burgeoning textile industry. Take a boat trip along Thu Bon river, en route stop to visit Thanh Ha pottery village.
 Lunch at local restaurant
 The rest of the day is free at leisure
 Accommodation at Hoi An Ancient House River resort, Superior double room
- 18 Apr 11 HOI AN – DANANG – SAIGON [B/L/-]
 Breakfast at the hotel
 Drive to Danang and transfer to the airport for the flight **VN1311 at 10.50am** and arrival in **Saigon at 12.00am**.
 Meet on arrival and starting to take half day city tour including: the History Museum, the former Presidential Palace, Central Post Office and Notre Dame Cathedral.
 Lunch at local restaurant
 Accommodation at Park Hyatt Hotel Saigon – *own arrangement*
- 19 Apr 11 HO CHI MINH – CAI BE – VINH LONG- HO CHI MINH [-/L/D]
 Coach trip to Cai Be (2 ½ hour drive from Ho Chi Minh City) and embark a wooden boat for the trip to Vinh Long. Visit first the canal where the colourful floating market of Cai Be takes place and then see locals producing rice popcorn and other sweets. Lunch will be served in a local restaurant. In the afternoon continue along fruit orchards in narrow canals to the city of Vinh Long on the other side of the Mekong River. Drive back to Saigon
 Dinner Indochine restaurant
 Accommodation at Park Hyatt Hotel Saigon – *own arrangement*

20 Apr 11 SAIGON [-/-/-]
Free at leisure
Accommodation at Park Hyatt Hotel Saigon – *own arrangement*

21 Apr 11 SAIGON DEPARTURE [-/-/-]
Transfer to the airport for the departure flight by **SQ173 at 13.10pm**
